In the F row, we find S is in the N column. In the R row, we find V in the E column. In the O row, we find K in the W column. In the G row, we find Y in the S column. In the F row, we find U in the P column, In the R row, we find R in the A column. In the O row, we find D in the P column...etc. Continue repeating the key until the answer is deciphers, in this case "NEWSPAPER"
